

Prize for the best article presented by a student at the 14^ª CNES**REGULATIONS**

1. Individual eligibility criteria:

- a) Being a member of APES;
- b) Being registered as a student, or having concluded her/his studies during the years 2014 or 2015, in a post graduate degree, Master or PhD in a national or international educational institution.
- c) Having submitted an abstract to the Scientific Committee of APES Conference and the abstract having been accepted for presentation at the conference.
- d) Being the first or main author of the submitted paper referred to in c);
- e) No authors of the article should belong to the jury.

2. The article should be original and not previously published.

3. The article must be written in English or Portuguese.

4. The individuals interested in being considered to the award must express their interest via email to be sent to apes@ensp.unl.pt with subject title "14CNES Prize for best article". The email must be sent by the 5th of September 2015 and should include the full article.

5. All authors authorize the publication of the articles on the APES website.

6. When the article is subsequently published in a scientific journal it must mention APES, the award and the conference on the Acknowledgments section. A copy of the published article should be sent by the award winner to APES.

7. The award consists of a monetary prize of 2.000 euros, and can be shared by more than one winning article.

8. The name(s) of the winner(s) will be announced during the plenary closing session of the 14^ª CNES, during which the prize will be given to the winner(s).

9. The jury's decisions shall be taken by a majority rule. The decision is final and there is no possibility for an appeal.

10. Any other relevant issues not contemplated in this document will be decided by the jury.
