

PRIZE FOR THE BEST POSTER PRESENTED AT THE 14^a CNES**Rules**

1. All posters accepted and exhibited at the conference will be eligible for the prize. To be eligible the posters should further be produced in accordance with the format suggested by APES.
2. The criteria for selection of the best poster are:
 - a. Scientific relevance in the field of health economics
 - b. Clarity of objectives
 - c. Research novelty
 - d. Adequacy of the methodology
 - e. Relevance of the findings and conclusions for health policy and/or health management
 - f. Global appraisal of the research
3. The poster will be scored in each criterion on a scale ranging from 0 (zero) to 5 (five)
4. Posters authored or co-authored by a member of the jury are not eligible for the prize
5. The decision of the jury will be taken by majority rule and there is no scope for appeal
6. The prize has a monetary value of 400 euros, and can be shared by more than one poster
7. The winner (s) will be announced during the 14^a CNES closing session during which the award will be given.
8. Any author with an accepted poster has the right to opt for not being considered for the prize award, in which case she/he shall inform the Scientific Commission of that choice until the beginning of the conference
9. Any omissions in these regulations will be decided by the jury.

The jury is composed by Luís Pereira (ESGHT/Universidade do Algarve), that chairs the jury; Claudia Furtado (INFARMED; ENSP/ Universidade Nova de Lisboa); Pedro Saramago (Centre for Health Economics, University of York, UK) and Bernardete Pinheiro (CISEP, ISEG/Universidade de Lisboa).
